

Introduction of Dr. Jonathan Shorr

Dr. Jonathan Shorr, or Jon Shorr for short, grew up in Cincinnati, Ohio. After attending college at Miami University, he taught Jr. and Sr. High School English in a suburban Cincinnati school district. He completed his Ph. D. at the University of Cincinnati. He lived in Hanover, Indiana for five years and taught at Hanover College. He then moved to Baltimore, Maryland where he was a professor and administrator for over 30 years at the University of Baltimore, until he retired. He continues to live in Baltimore.

Jon is a reader, photographer and cook. He also writes feature articles for magazines, and fiction and essays for literary journals.
