

Juliet Miles: A Story of Courage and Sacrifice

Description: Juliet Miles and her son were emancipated by Rev. John G. Fee in 1851 and moved to Felicity, Ohio, sixteen miles from her enslaved family members in Kentucky. Juliet was arrested and captured on the banks of the Ohio River in an attempt to help her enslaved children and grandchildren in Kentucky. Her family was sold down river, and she was sentenced to three years in the Kentucky penitentiary where she died in prison after serving two years.
